

SAN MARINO ROTARY CLUB

President Stanley H. Stevens' Year
1968-69

Stanley Stevens was installed as President of the Rotary Club of San Marino June 21, 1968 at the Huntington Sheraton Hotel. Stanley was the first "second-generation" President of the San Marino Rotary Club.

President Stan attended the Rotary International Convention in Mexico. It was commented by a member that President Stan's report was like a girl's bikini bathing suit. Stan did remark that of the 90,000 students enrolled in the University of Mexico, there was not one student wearing a beard.

Rotary International raised the dues from \$6.00 per year to \$8.00 for each Rotarian but the Club and District absorbed this increase.

He informed the club that the Rotary organization had more than 632,000 members in some 13,266 clubs in 143 countries.

Members of the Rotary Club, Stan Clark, Don Scott, Birk Lefler, Ham Stevens, Louis Kunert, Ron Witter, and Wally Weirick encouraged participation of all in building a first-class tennis facility in the northwest corner of Lacy Park.

An auction was held November 14. Proceeds went to increase the club's participation in Rotary Foundation. Items to be auctioned off included two Rose Bowl tickets, a clock, and one share of stock. The auction grossed \$1,483.

President Stan did his work so efficiently that he was appointed to the committee to nominate a District Governor for 1970-71.

The sixtieth annual convention of Rotary International was held in Honolulu, May, 1969.

Honored guests for President Stan's semi-annual club assembly were District Governor Andy Yarber and Governor Representative Jimmy Jackson.

Alisal in Ojai.

Many members attended the Rotary District 530 Conference at the Bahia Hotel in San Diego where President Stan carried off some important District trophies for our club.
