Focus for International Projects



- 2015/6     \$10,000
- 2016/7     \$15,000
- 2017/8     \$16,000

including \$8,000 from Mead fund and \$7,896 from Blair/Wadsworth fund

Budget for International Projects

- 2016 - Classroom furniture for school in Kabaale, Uganda \$1,400
- 2016 – Early detection and treatment of women’s cancers at ProSalud in Tijuana, Mexico \$8,000 (global grant with RC Tijuana Oeste total \$35,000)
- 2016 – Water supply for Raul Anguiano Kindergarten in Tijuana, Mexico \$8,000 (global grant with RC Tijuana Independencia total \$36,000). Project initiated in 2016 and completed in January 2018
- 2016 – Aquaponics Farm School in Sen Sok, Cambodia \$3,400. Project completed in February 2018
